¹ 21 DE Code §2115. Violations of registration provisions. No person shall: (1) Operate or, being the owner of any motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer, knowingly permit the operation upon a highway of any motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer which is not registered or which does not have attached thereto and displayed thereon the number plate or plates assigned thereto by the Department and unexpired registration plate or plates, subject to the exemptions allowed in this title, or under temporary or limited permits as otherwise provided by this title;

2. Administrative Conditions

- 2.1 This permit shall be in the permittee's possession during the on-board diagnostic testing of any 1996 or newer motor vehicle that is not in compliance with 21 DE Code §2115(1).
- 2.2 Testing equipment for an on board diagnostic test shall be installed in the vehicle during all on-board diagnostic testing.
- 2.3 The permittee shall maintain, and possess evidence of during the on-board diagnostic testing of any 1996 or newer motor vehicle that is not in compliance with 21 DE Code §2115(1), a current applicable garage keeper's policy that provides required insurance coverage for such operation.
- 2.4 Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may be grounds for suspension or revocation of this permit, and citation by law enforcement for violation of **21 DE Code 2115**.
- 2.5 The sole purpose of this permit is to provide for the conduct of on-board diagnostic testing of 1996 or newer vehicles that are not in compliance with 21 DE Code §2115(1). This permit does not relieve the permittee from the need to comply with any other applicable Delaware law or regulation.
